Wednesday, August 11, 2010

PLEASE NOTE that the first day of school for students in first grade through eighth grade will be Wednesday, August 25th. This is the same day that the Geneva School District starts. As always, school will begin at 8:30 a.m. Students may begin arriving at 8:10 a.m. (There is no supervision before 8:10 a.m.) However, school will dismiss on the first day at 1:00 p.m. Bus service to and from school will be provided for those who meet the Geneva School District requirements. In addition, if you have a child in preschool or kindergarten, please note the dates for his/her orientation. They are indicated on the school calendar, which is on our website.

Reminder . . . NO SIGN-UP DAY! All forms are available electronically OR parents may stop by the school office to pick up any forms that they cannot download. Forms that are completed may be dropped off at the school. The school office is open every Tuesday and Thursday from 8:00 a.m. until noon. On Monday, August 23rd, the school office will resume normal hours of operation from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Completed forms may also be returned by mail or placed in the drop box outside the school office at any hour of the day or night.

EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM! Once again, this is the most important form that we need as soon as possible. If you scroll down, you will find it at the end of this note. As soon as St. Peter School receives your completed EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM, we will personally contact you with the name of your child's/children's homeroom teacher. The response has been incredible so far . . . thank you!!!

WHO ELSE IS IN MY CLASS?: Class lists will be posted on the windows of the school entrance on August 24 at 5:00 p.m.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES: School supply lists are online on our website, or they can be picked up in the school office. Remember, the State of Illinois is offering "tax-free" back-to-school shopping for school related items until **August 15.** Don't miss this opportunity to save some money!

HOT LUNCH: Our Hot Lunch program will be automated this year allowing you to pay for your children's meals with an automatic checking account deduction. We will share the September menu from Sodexo and the ordering procedure as soon as possible.

ILLINOIS HEALTH REQUIREMENTS! The Illinois Health Requirements were attached to the first Wednesday Packet (August 4). Please read them carefully and be certain that you have complied with all of the state's requirements. All of the forms are available as downloads from our website or in the school office.

WOULD YOU LIKE TO VOLUNTEER AT SCHOOL? If so, please contact Lisa O'Leary Volk in the Parish Office (630-232-0124). She will provide you with a packet of information that must be completed. All individuals volunteering at school, whether it be weekly in the lunch room or simply one day for a class field trip, must complete the volunteer requirements.
