

# **Native American Project and Presentation**

**Diorama Due 1/3/12**

A diorama is a three-dimensional scene in which figures, stuffed wildlife, or other objects are arranged in a naturalistic setting against a painted or decorated background.

You are to create a Diorama of the Native American tribe you have chosen. Your diorama should represent your Native American tribe's culture. Display something that interests you. Be creative! Use your textbook for ideas, books from the library, and the internet (with your parent's permission).

During your oral presentation, you will present your diorama. You will need to describe the following:

What you made.

How is it used?

How does it represent your tribe's culture?

What materials did you use to make it?

The maximum base size of your diorama should be 18 x 18. Use natural resources when you can (tree bark, tall grass, dried flowers, rocks, pebbles and twigs). Be sure to have your tribe's name and your name displayed on your diorama.
